

Propane Safety



1. **NO FLAMES OR SPARKS!** Immediately put out all smoking materials and other open flames. Do not operate lights, appliances, telephones, or cell phones. Flames or sparks from these sources can trigger an explosion or a fire.



2. **LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY!** Get everyone out of the building or area where you suspect gas is leaking.



3. **SHUT OFF THE GAS.** Turn off the main gas supply valve on your propane tank if it is safe to do so. To close the valve turn it right (clockwise).



4. **REPORT THE LEAK.** From a neighbour's house or other nearby building away from the gas leak, call your propane retailer right away. If you can't reach your propane retailer, call 911 or your local fire department.



5. **DO NOT RETURN TO THE BUILDING OR AREA** until your propane retailer, emergency responder, or qualified service technician determines that it is safe to do so.



6. **GET YOUR SYSTEM CHECKED.** Before you attempt to use any of your propane appliances, your propane retailer or qualified technician must check your entire system to ensure it is leak free.

In comparison to other safe and efficient fuel sources, propane gas is the first choice for clean energy that can be used for a variety of residential, commercial, and industrial needs.

Carbon Emissions: Propane gas contains significantly less carbon than many types of fuel for which it can be used as a substitute, including diesel fuel, gasoline, and coal. This is reflected in comparing propane's greenhouse gas emissions per productivity unit to those of other fuel sources. Even natural gas, which generates fewer carbon emissions per productivity unit than propane, ultimately has a heavier impact on the environment because of the methane that is released into the air as it is burned.

Propane gas is non-toxic and contains no lead. Upon vaporization, propane dissipates rapidly. All of these factors make propane's impact on the earth and soil negligible.
